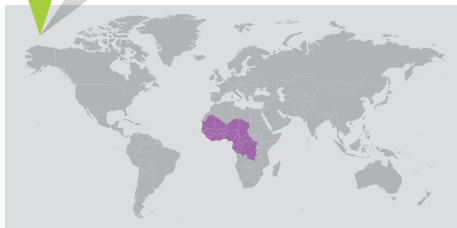


WHS Consultations

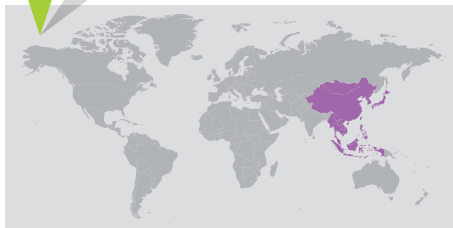


1 West and Central Africa Côte d'Ivoire, 19–20 June 2014



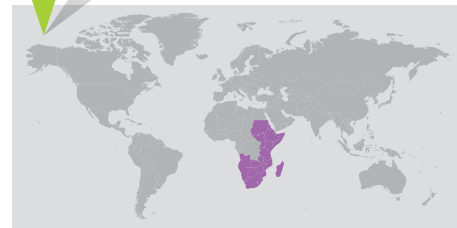
